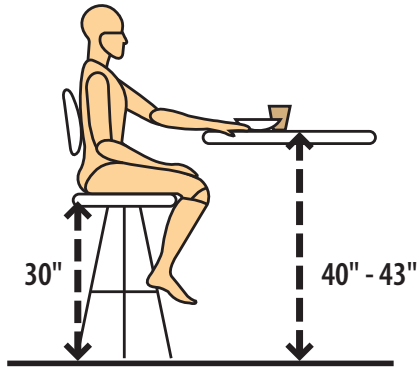
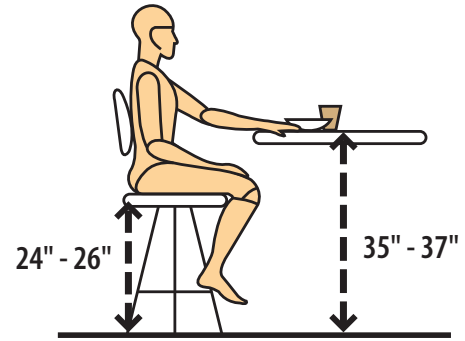


how to measure for barstools & counterstools



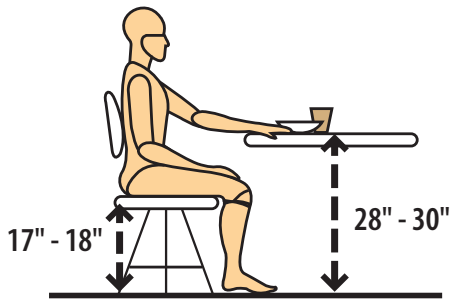
Bar

A bar usually stands between 40" and 43" high from the floor to the top of the surface. A stool with a seat height of 30" is required.



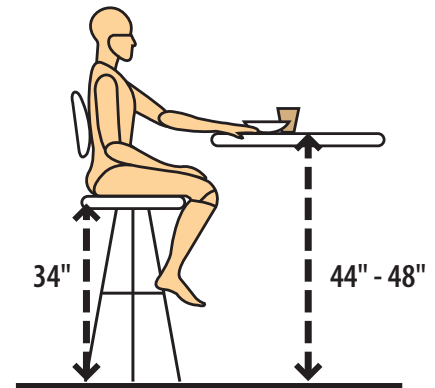
Kitchen Counter

A standard kitchen counter usually stands between 35" and 37" high from the floor to the top of the surface. A stool with a seat height between 24" to 26" is required.



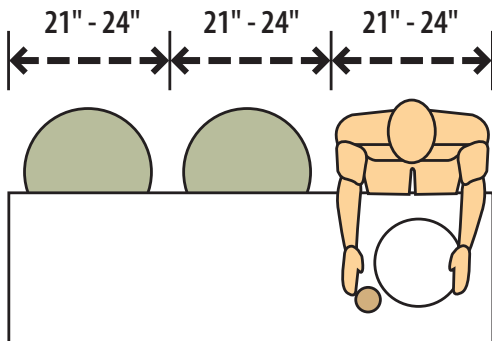
Kitchen, Desk or Vanity Table

A kitchen, desk or vanity table usually stands between 28" and 30" high from the floor to the top of the surface. A chair or stool with a seat height between 17" to 18" is required.



Standing Bar and Theatre Bar

A theatre counter usually stands between 44" and 48" high from the floor to the top of the surface. A stool with a seat height of 34" is required. This is a custom order item.



how many stools fit comfortably at a counter?

Width Requirements

When the widest part of the stool measures between 16" to 22" you must foresee a space ranging from 21" to 24".

In general, you should allow 2 feet per stool.
